Please note that we have changed the location back to Croydon Pool (Next to the Hall). Meet and kickoff at the pool at 7pm and finish at 9pm.

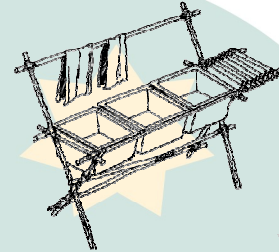


Friday August 5th (AT SCOUT HALL - Scorpions on Flag Duty -Tigers on Hall Duty)

Cross Country Ski-ing at Lake Mountain.

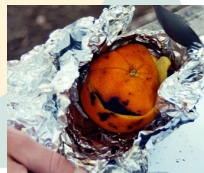
Let's carve up the trail and have a great time amongst some amazing scenery!

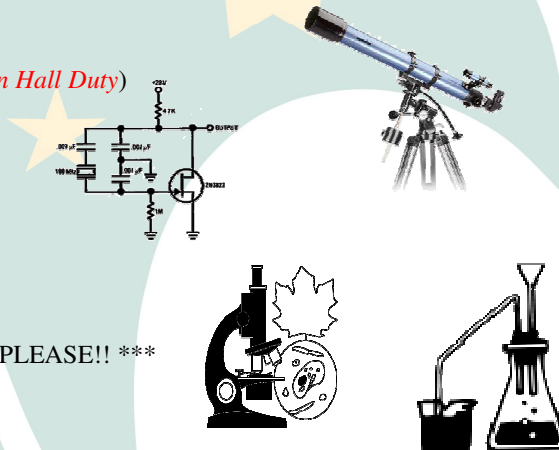
Science Night.

No *OINGO – BOINGO* or *THOMAS DOLBY* related references or activities PLEASE!! ***

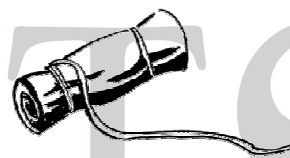


Friday September 23rd (*AT SCOUT HALL - Tigers on Flag Duty - Platypi on Hall Duty*)
